HISTORY



THE FIRST EXPLORERS

Local Maori had long known of the existence of caves in the Waitomo region, however they chose not to reveal their secret until 1887, when Chief Tane Tinorau was persuaded to explore the Waitomo Glowworm Caves by an English surveyor, Fred Mace. They floated into the cave via the Waitomo river on a raft of flax stems, with candles as their only lighting.

Imagine their excitement as their eyes adjusted to the darkness and they became aware of the multitude of glowworm lights around them! They returned many times, finding easier access points and discovering extraordinary limestone formations.

Government surveyors later mapped the cave and by 1889 the cave had opened to visitors. Many of the staff employed at the Waitomo Glowworm Caves today are direct descendants of Chief Tane Tinorau.

ARANUI CAVE

In 1910, a young Maori named Ruruku Aranui and his dog discovered a new cave in the bush. A wild pig they were chasing disappeared into a hole in the side of the hill and the dog followed in hot pursuit. Its barking led Ruruku to the hole and crawling inside, he discovered a huge cavern.

The richly decorated Aranui Cave is a geological rarity and is considered to be one of the most beautiful caves in Waitomo. Guided tours take you along safe boardwalks into tall narrow chambers. The stunning shades of pink, white and pale brown stalactites are truly spectacular.

Aranui Cave is a 'must see' when visiting Waitomo.



THE CAVES

LIMESTONE

About 30 million years ago, when Waitomo lay quietly beneath the sea, the remains of countless marine creatures settled gently on the seabed and accumulated to form the rock strata we call limestone – made up almost purely of fossils and the mineral Calcium Carbonate (CaCO_3).

THE CAVES

Over the last 24 million years, the Waitomo landscape has been shaped by faulting, earthquakes and volcanic eruptions. The limestone layers were pushed up from the sea floor, buckled and broken. Cracks and joints separating the huge blocks allowed water to flow between them, gradually dissolving and carving out the caves that we see today. Inside the caves, stalactites, stalagmites and other cave decorations began to grow, formed over time as water gradually dripped from the roof, dropped to the floor or flowed over the walls and rocks.

STALACTITES AND STALAGMITES


These fascinating limestone decorations are formed by water dripping from the roof, falling to and flowing over cave walls leaving in its wake a deposit of crystalline Calcium Carbonate (CaCO_3).

Crystal layers accumulate over time, growing longer or thicker - stalactites hang down from the cave ceiling, and stalagmites grow up from the cave floor - creating 'living sculptures' of breathtaking beauty and majesty.

Cave decorations can take hundreds of years to form. It has been estimated that it can take about 100 years to form 1 cubic centimetre of stalactite.

1. EGGS

The female fly lays around 120 small spherical eggs. After around 20 days the young larvae hatch from the eggs.



4. ADULT

The adult glowworm looks like a large mosquito. They have no mouth and their only function is to reproduce and disperse the species. Usually a male is waiting for the female to emerge from the pupa, mating takes place immediately and the cycle continues. Adults live no longer than a few days.





2. LARVA

After hatching, the young larvae build a nest, put down lines and feed. Sticky substances on the lines trap insects and these are drawn up and devoured. Even at this small size, less than 3 millimetres long, they emit a visible light and slowly grow over 9 months to the shape and size of a matchstick.




3. PUPA

The pupa is the same as the cocoon stage in the butterfly lifecycle; it is the stage between the larva and the adult fly. This will last about 13 days with the pupa suspended by a thread.

It is the larval stage of a two-winged insect which gives off light to attract food in the form of other flying insects. To survive, the glowworm needs a special habitat: humidity to prevent it from drying out, a sheltered surface to hang from and suspend its sticky, spider-like feeding lines, a calm atmosphere to prevent the lines from tangling, darkness to allow its light to attract food and a plentiful supply of insects to eat. The Waitomo Glowworm Caves provides a perfect environment, with an abundance of insects brought into the cave via the river.

A route was chosen from seven proposed in 1877 because it opened up the best area of Crown lands, presented the fewest engineering difficulties and was the most direct route to Dunedin. By the mid-1870s the gold rushes were well past and attention was being focused on the agricultural and pastoral potentials of Dunedin's hinterland. Roads were notoriously bad and railways were seen to offer the best means of improving transport and communications.


Construction of the railway began in June 1879, but within a year it had become a victim of the economic depression that persisted through the 1880s. It was 1889 before the first section was opened to traffic, and it took another 27km to Hindon in the middle of the Taieri Gorge. The line reached Haldane in 1891 and thereafter progress was slow; the rails reached Ranfurly in 1898, Omakau in 1906 and Clyde in 1907. Here work stopped until 1914 and it was not until 1921 that the line was completed to Cromwell.

By late arrival, the railway played a major part in the development of Central Otago. Thousands of tons of produce and fruit, and hundreds of thousands of livestock were railed yearly to Dunedin and beyond. Supplies for Central Otago went by rail from Dunedin that travelled overnight for early deliveries in the country towns.

Engineering protected the railway from 1900 until 1961 for the carriage of gold, and until 1983 for general freight. In 1980 the Clyde Dam required the closure of the line between Clyde and Cromwell, cutting cement and steel for the dam business for the railway until 1989. That year the Minister of Railways announced that the line would be closed on 30 April.

Taieri Railway

The Mayor of Dunedin announced that the City would finance a line through the Taieri Gorge and as far as possible the community raised \$1 million to finance


